## CYC Buoy Course Marks (position relative to $\mathrm{R} / \mathrm{C}$ )

Please note that the Sailing Instructions for a particular race may use modified or different mark descriptions than described here.


The course diagram for buoy course marks shows the general orientation of the race committee signal boat ("R/C"), other marks (identified by the letters $\mathrm{S}, \mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}$, $\mathrm{C}, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{G}, \mathrm{X}, \mathrm{Y}, \mathrm{Z}$ and F , and the intended wind direction. All marks other than the race committee signal boat are inflatable buoys. Positions are approximate and the diagram is not to scale.

Notes:
S When a starting mark for a downwind start, may be on either side of the race committee signal boat.
